

Bunker Park Stable Homeschool Equestrian Course 2026

Thank you for choosing Bunker Park Stable! Our homeschool program is a great way for horse lovers to have a fun, safe introduction to horses and western riding.

Please read through the following ***Homeschool Equestrian Course Details and Requirements*** before you make your decision.

- We are offering a program designed for students who are homeschooled during the day and looking for an activity to do with horses.
- Students will spend the first half hour in the barn getting their horse ready, followed by one hour of riding.
- Lessons are offered and structured for students ages 8-17.
- We strive to create a program that is suitable for most riders with a variety of learning styles, ages, and abilities. Riders come in with many different background experiences and different learning goals that they would like to achieve. Not everyone learns at the same pace, there will be times of struggle and we want riders to learn how to work through the struggles with the skills they learn. Each horse is an individual and presents its own challenges and learning opportunities.
- Lessons are taught by qualified instructors to ensure students receive a safe and educational experience.
- Sessions will include demonstrations, discussions, horse safety and care, grooming, tacking, and structured western riding practices.
- Sessions are designed as a group activity, students need to be able to complete tasks independently under the guidance of the instructor. The instructor needs to divide their time equally between all the students to ensure everyone progresses and has a positive experience.
- Lessons may not be appropriate for riders with special needs, physical limitations, or neurodiversities that may impede their ability to work independently in a group setting. At Bunker Park Stable, rider safety is our top priority. Horseback riding requires a certain level of physical ability, including balance, strength, and coordination to maintain control and respond to the horse's movements. Please call the office at 763-757-9445 prior to registering for camp to discuss your individual needs and abilities, as horseback riding may not be suitable for everyone. Please understand that this decision is made solely with your safety and wellbeing in mind. Arena/trail environments can be unpredictable, and we are committed to ensuring that every participant, and every horse, remains secure and comfortable throughout the experience.
- The weight limit is 225 pounds.
- Attire: Long pants, closed-toe shoes (boots or tennis shoes) are required. Dress accordingly for the weather each day, lessons are held rain or shine.
- Arrival time is a minimum of 5 minutes before the start of each lesson. Late arrival: If you arrive 10 minutes after the lesson has started you will not join the lesson that week.
- Certified Equestrian Helmets are required for students under 18 and will be provided.
- If a lesson is missed there are no make-up lessons available. If you cancel your registration or miss a lesson you will not get a refund or credit. This policy will apply regardless of COVID-19, subject to any local consumer laws.
- In the event we would cancel due to extreme cold or dangerous weather, we will offer an alternative date.
- Non-Refundable, Non-Transferable full payment is due at time of registration
- *Non-Transferable payment: monies cannot be used by or for anyone other than the registered student, for the selected session.*
