

## **Bunker Park Stable Equine Camp 2025**

Thank you for choosing Bunker Park Stable! Our day camps are a great way for young horse lovers to have a fun, safe introduction to horses and western riding.

Please read through the following ***Equestrian Day Camp Details and Requirements*** before you make your camp selections.

- We offer 1-day to 5-day camps, along with full and half-day options for riders of all levels and abilities.
- Camps are offered and structured for different age groups.
  - ages 8-17 : equestrian camp
  - ages 7-8 : peewee transition camp
  - ages 5-7 : peewee camp
  - ages 4-6 : pony camp
- We strive to create a program that is suitable for most riders with a variety of learning styles, ages, and abilities. Riders come in with many different background experiences and different learning goals that they would like to achieve. Not everyone learns at the same pace, there will be times of struggle and we want riders to learn how to work through the struggles with the skills they learn. Each horse is an individual and presents its own challenges and learning opportunities.
- Camps are taught by qualified instructors to ensure campers receive a safe and educational experience.
- Campers are responsible for a horse or pony for the duration of their camp.
- Camps will include demonstrations, discussions, structured riding practices, and lots of hands on time with horses.
- Camps are designed as a group activity, students need to be able to complete tasks independently under the guidance of the instructors. Instructors need to divide their time equally between all the students to ensure everyone progresses and has a positive experience.
- Camps may not be appropriate for riders with special needs, physical limitations, or neurodiversity that may impede their ability to work independently in a group setting.  
Please call the office at 763-757-9445 prior to registering for camp to discuss your riders individual needs. If camps are not a suitable option, we will do our best to provide an alternative activity.
- Weight limit 225 pounds.
- Attire: Long pants, closed-toe shoes (boots or tennis shoes) are required. Dress accordingly for the weather each day, including sunscreen and bug spray.
- Certified Equestrian Helmets are required and will be provided.
- Bring a bag lunch and drink daily. Refrigeration is not available, plan accordingly.
- Cancellation of a Summer Camp registration must be in writing, sent via email a minimum of 15 days prior to the start of camp. The registration deposit is non-refundable and non-transferable. Our email address is: [bunkerparkstableoffice@gmail.com](mailto:bunkerparkstableoffice@gmail.com).
- ***Non-Transferable deposit:*** monies cannot be used by, or for, anyone other than the registered child, for the selected camp.
